Sr.Jinsa Rose CMC and Sr.Nithya CMC are the external counsellors and the number of students benefited is 211.

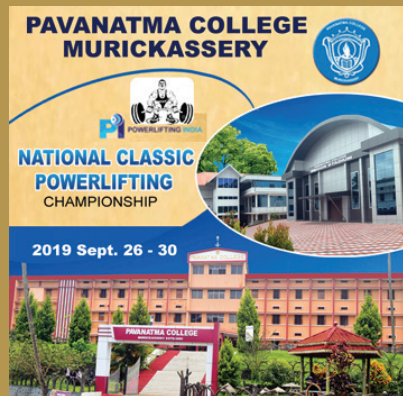
MAR MATHEW ANIKUZHICKATTIL GOLD MEDAL

EXTENSION ACTIVITIES

The college has created a cell '**outreach cell**' for coordinating and guiding all the extension activities of different clubs, forums and departments.
