It is certainly a heart-rending venture for me to commemorate the enriching but lost presence of His Excellency Mar Mathew Anikuzhikattil, my il padre. He has gone, but never forgotten since he was the watchtower on our pathway. Bishop Anikuzhikattil meant personally a great deal for me. He brought joy, peace, and contentment to all who approached him and I'm sure that he is sorely missed by everyone.

During the blessed journey of twenty one years of priesthood, Mar Anikuzhikattil was my guide and spiritual promoter. His paternal love, concern, and compassion enhanced all my endeavours. I cherish those unforgettable moments of togetherness in which there were diverging opinions, ideas, and ideologies as well. It's really amazing that he maintained relationships in spite of all disparities.

Bishop Anikuzhikattil is a man of wisdom and perseverance. Being at the forefront of genuine undertakings such as the farmers' protests in the High Ranges, he proved to be a meticulous humanitarian. Born and brought up in an agrarian background, he was capable of identifying the injustice and discrimination that the marginalized sectors confront with. And it's quite natural for the bishop to be empathetic with the less privileged and raise voice for their uplifting. And the people of Idukki witnessed their bishop's untiring efforts to convince the ruling classes about the requirements of the oppressed. Consequently, Mar Anikuzhikattil became the matchless voice of the voiceless.

Mar Anikuzhikattil's simplicity is truly inspiring and motivational. Though he had the possibilities of having the luxuries, he always chose the smallest and the humblest. This indicates his solidarity with the poor and needy. In the Book of Isaiah, we read about the mission of the anointed: "to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, and provide for those who grieve in Zion" (61: 2-3). It was the same great mission that our beloved bishop fulfilled in the midst of the backwardness of Idukki.

His Excellency is a man of determined determination. Hard work is quite apt a synonym for him. Being least bothered about his personal comforts or physical health, he dedicated his time, energy, and charisma for the well-being of the people. This good shepherd had a broader vision on the Church and her mission. He was not ready to compromise the values which he believes as the corner stones of the Catholic faith. For example, regarding the controversial issues such as population, euthanasia, abortion, and inter caste marriage, bishop showed the authenticity to speak out. And always he dreamt a society where everyone lives in harmony and peace. We could see a consistency between his words and actions. Though he faced thousands of stumbling blocks on the path of pastoral service and administration, he overcame them with deepened faith and trust in the Divine Providence. This great man of prayer depended Mother Mary like a baby trusts its mother. "Divinization" was his motto which in Christian theology, is "the transforming effect of divine grace, the spirit of God, or the atonement of Christ. It literally means to become more divine, more like God, and or take upon a divine nature". This concept truly materialised in our bishop and he tried his level best to divinize people and circumstances. With a deep sense of gratitude and affection I place on record the intimacy we maintained till the end. I enjoyed the liberty of a son or soul mate with him and recall the opportunities that I got to take care of him while he was fighting with physical ailments. He enjoyed cracking jokes and those occasions of fun and entertainment come flooded in my memory. I acknowledge humbly all my appointments, especially while I make this note, let it be a tribute of Pavanatma College family for her loving captain. Trusting me, he extended freedom and support, except them no development strategies would have happened here.

From the bottom of my heart, I wish and pray that his soul may enjoy eternal bliss!
