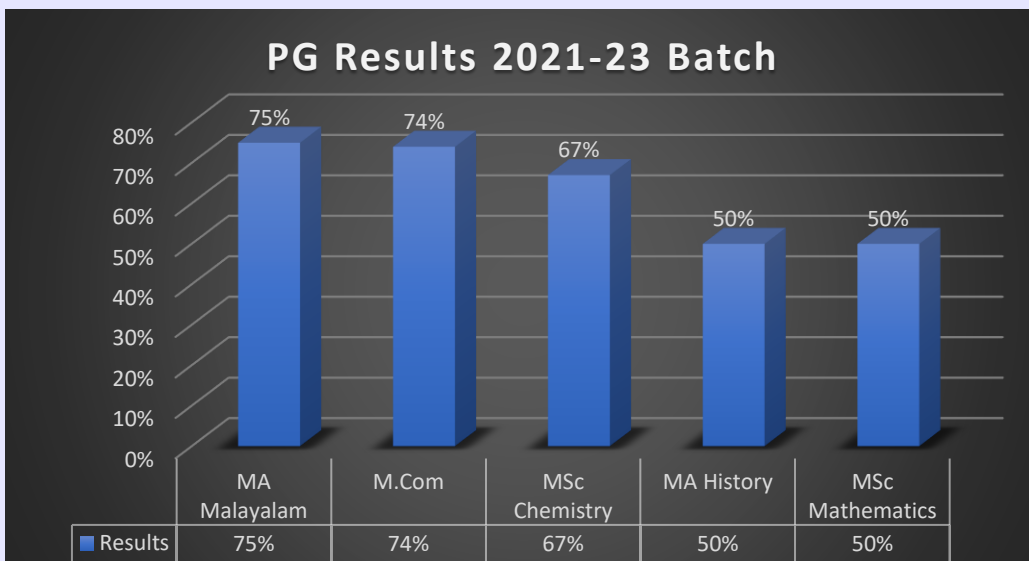
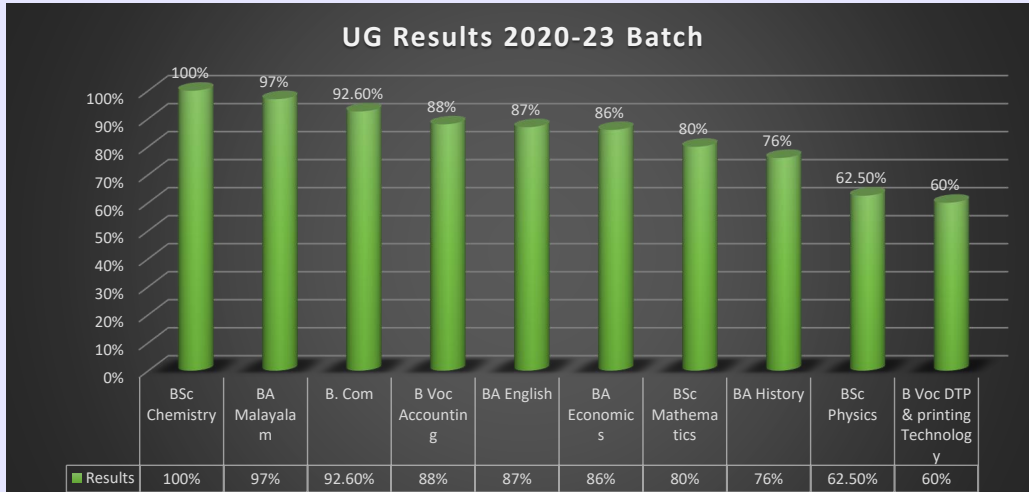
## LIBRARY



Library provides a reading room equipped with Newspapers, Journals, and magazines easily accessible for all. Free access to the Internet facility is also provided for all the users. Special reference sections are maintained for Career Guidance, Kerala History, Gandhian Studies, and various competitive exams. The working hours of the library is from 8.30 AM to 5 PM.

In order to cater to the information needs of the student community the library provides access to 20,581 books, 19 journals, 37 magazines and 7 periodicals. Library is equipped with user friendly interface softwares like ILMS and KOHA. It also facilitates Web OPAC remote access to users and provides a platform to both students and teachers for N LIST subscription of Inflibnet. This inflibnet facility provides access to more than 6000 journals and 164800 e-books beneficial for students and research scholars.

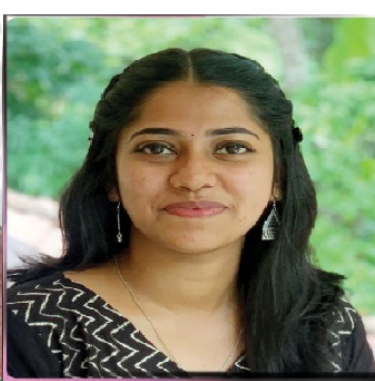

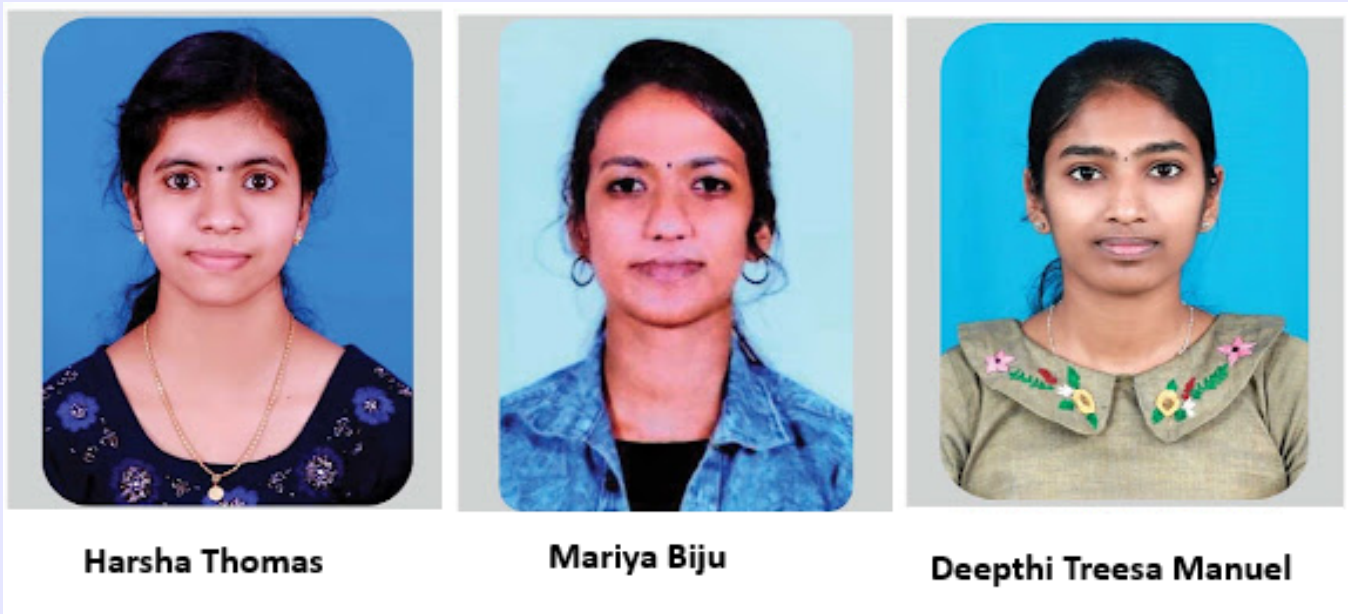

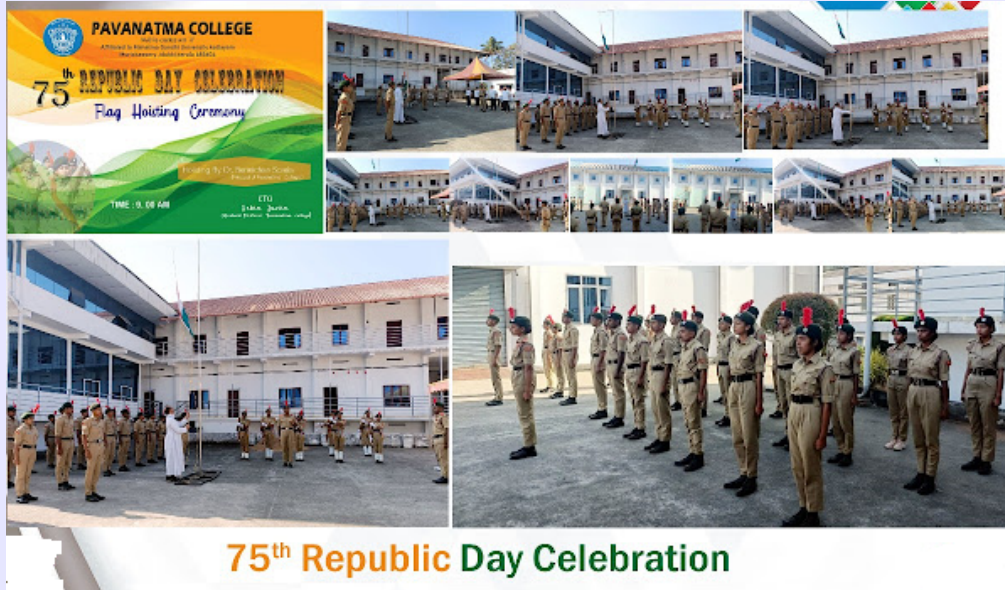
