1. ABOUT PAVANATMA COLLEGE

Government Aided College, Affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam, located at Murickassery, about 15 kms away from Idukki en route to Thopramkudy, in Vathikudy Panchayath, Udumbanchola Taluk, Idukki District. Pavanatma is affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. It was established in 1982. The Management was transferred to the Diocese of Idukki in the year 2005 followed by the bifurcation of the Kothamangalam Diocese. At present His Excellency Mar. John Nellikunnel, Bishop of Idukki is the Patron of the College. Under the efficient guidance of the corporate Educational Agency, Idukki, the College marches forward along the path of progress with 8 UG HONOURS programmes and 2 UG B.Voc. Programmes, 5 PG Programmes and 1 Research Centre.

2. ABOUT MG UNIVERSITY CAP AND ADMISSION PROSPECTUS -2025

Mahatma Gandhi University introduced the Centralised Allotment Process (CAP) in the academic year 2010-2011. The greatest advantage of CAP is that the applicants need to submit only one application online for admission to any number of Colleges/Programmes. First of all, the marks /grades secured by a candidate at the +2 level decide the eligibility for admission to UG programmes. Under the Pre-CAP system, the applicants had to visit various institutions for the submission of applications and to keep in contact with them to get updates on the progress of admission procedure. CAP, on the other hand, opened a single window eliminating wastage of time, effort and money, besides minimising the element of anxiety from the point of the applicant. UG CAP -Prospectus - 2025 and PGCAP-Prospectus - 2025 provides the complete information about the online allotment process, and details of the colleges and programmes. These Prospectus sets out the rules and regulations for selection and admission to the four-year undergraduate programmes (MG UGP) and post graduate programmes in affiliated arts and science colleges of the University for the academic year 2025 - 26 through Centralised Allotment Process.



3. MGU HONOURS PROGRAMMES

3.1 MGU Graduate Programmes (Honours) Regulations 2025 and Course Structure of the MGU-UGP Programmes

The MGU-UGP consists of the following categories of courses and the minimum credit requirements for pathway option-one based on MGU Graduate Programmes (Honours) Regulations 2025 shall be as follows:

* The students can acquire advanced/ capstone level courses with 12 credits from their DSC/ DSE/ Minor courses depending up on their pathway choice. The Minor courses can be of level 300 or above.

** The students perusing the 4-year honours with research have to complete a project with 12 credits and for the 4-year honours degree students have to complete a project with 8 credits and DSC/ DSE capstone/ advanced level course in the 8th semester.

i) 20% syllabus of each course will be prepared by the teacher as 'Teacher Specific Content' and will be evaluated under CCA.

ii) In case of MDC, SEC, VAC courses coming under 3rd & 4th semester, college should make necessary arrangements to give adequate preference to courses designed by language departments. MDC in the 3rd semester can be Kerala Specific Content

4. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Academic eligibility should be satisfied as on the last date of submission of academic data. In the case of candidates who have passed examinations of other Boards/Institutes/Governments, except CBSE/CISCE, they shall be admitted only if these examinations have been declared equivalent to the qualifying examinations of MG University.

4.1 ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION - UG HONOURS PROGRAMMES

1. B.Com Honours

Admission to the B.Com Honours Degree Programmes shall be open only to candidates who have passed the Plus Two or equivalent examination recognized by this University with Book-Keeping and Accountancy and any two of the following subjects, viz., (1) Commerce (2) Commercial Correspondence and Commercial Geography (3) Economics (4) Life Insurance with Salesmanship (5) Banking with Secretarial Practice (6) Business Studies (7) Mathematics (8) Computer Science/Computer applications (9) Informatics Practice & Management, (10) Informatics Practice, (11) Management, (12) Accountancy as optional under Part III of the Examination. OR Have passed Plus Two or equivalent examination recognized by this University with other subjects under Part III optional subjects provided they have secured 45% of the aggregate marks.

2. Bachelor of Arts (BA) Honours Degree Programmes (BA Honours Malayalam & BA Honours English):

Admission to all BA Honours Degree Programmes under the faculties of Language & Literature, Fine Arts and Social Sciences/Integrated MA Programme in Languages -English shall be open only to candidates who have passed Plus Two or equivalent examination or an examination recognised by this University as equivalent thereto. For BA Sanskrit Language and Literature programme in addition to the above qualifications, candidates should have working knowledge in Sanskrit. For BA Tamil programme in addition to the normal eligibility criteria, candidates should have working knowledge in Tamil and studied Tamil as second language at SSLC or equivalent examinations. For BA Arabic Language and Literature programme in addition to the normal eligibility criteria, candidates should have working knowledge in Arabic and studied Arabic in Secondary/ Higher Secondary /Equivalent course.

3. Bachelor of Arts (Honours) Economics: Candidates shall be required to have passed Plus Two or equivalent examination or an examination recognised by this University as equivalent thereto.

4. Bachelor of Arts (Honours) History: Candidates shall be required to have passed Plus Two or equivalent examination or an examination recognised by this University as equivalent thereto.

5. Bachelor of Science (Honours) Chemistry: Candidates shall be required to have passed the Plus Two/equivalent examination with Chemistry as one of the optional subjects at Plus Two level.

6. Bachelor of Science (Honours) Mathematics: Candidates shall be required to have passed the Plus Two/equivalent examination with Mathematics as one of the optional subjects or Mathematics as one of the subjects in Commerce group.

7. Bachelor of Science (Honours) Physics: Candidates shall be required to have passed the Plus Two/equivalent examination with Physics as one of the optional subjects at Plus Two level.

4.2 ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION - UG B.VOC PROGRAMMES

1.B Voc Animation and Graphic Design: Candidates shall be required to have passed Plus Two or equivalent examination or an examination recognised by this University as equivalent thereto.

2. B Voc Business Accounting and Taxation: Candidates shall be required to have passed the Plus Two /equivalent examination recognised by the University in any stream.

4.3 ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION - PG PROGRAMMES

The minimum requirements for admission to PG Degree Programmes are detailed in M.G.University Prospectus-2025 (Refer Page No.12)

5. GENERAL RULES

1. The candidates seeking admission to UG/PG programmes should register their names through the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) of the Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. Candidates are required to go through the prospectus issued by the university carefully and familiarize themselves with all the relevant information relating to the admission process.

2. The entire admission process of the college is strictly based on the university and government instructions and guidelines.

3. Candidates who wish to apply to seats under management quota shall apply directly to the college. They can download the application form from the college website. However, such candidates should apply through CAP initially and submit the copy of the application/CAP application number to the college. The CAP application number is essential for online registration of Management Quota.

4.Community Quota applications are also submitted through University CAP Portal.

5. Management Quota Seats are available for all courses ie, both for Aided and Unaided (Self Financing) Programmes but Community Quota are available only for Aided Programmes. Only applicants belonging to the community which runs the institution can apply under community quota.

6. The detailed information's about academic eligibility is available in the MGU CAP-UG&P.G Prospectus 2025 issued by the university.
